

Current Trail Alignment Proposal

1. The proposed multi-use trail and parking area would only be accessible after paving/construction of the road is complete. This means trail access in Berry Creek **COULD BE CLOSED FOR 2 YEARS**.
2. The proposed new multi-use trail would be on the same grade as the road and only separated from vehicles by a 3' shoulder
3. There would not be a soft surface connection to FSR780. To access, a user must get on pavement at the Endo Alley trailhead.

Vail Valley Mountain Bike Association's Comments

1. The VVMBA proposes the following soft surface multi-use trails in the Berry Creek trail system:
 - A. Build a new multi-use trail connecting the trailhead parking area at the existing gate on FSR 774 to Moonridge Drive. This would create a looped multi-use soft surface trail system.
 - B. Build a multi-use trail on the existing non-maintained road/hiking trail to access Lower Berry Creek Trail and Endo Alley new multi-use soft surface connection to FSR780.
 - C. Keep proposed new multi-use trail along FSR774 to allow soft surface trail access to the Mesquite Trail, June Creek, West Avon Preserve Trail System, and the Singletree Community
 - D. Create a soft surface singletrack connection to FSR780. This trail could also be used by Berlaimont homeowners to access Endo Alley.
 - E. Create a connecting trail from 1-C to Lower Berry Creek Trail. This connector would allow users to create a shorter soft surface loop option if they do not want to ascend to Endo Alley.
2. Most importantly, build these trails prior to road construction to ensure access remains OPEN during the entire construction process.
